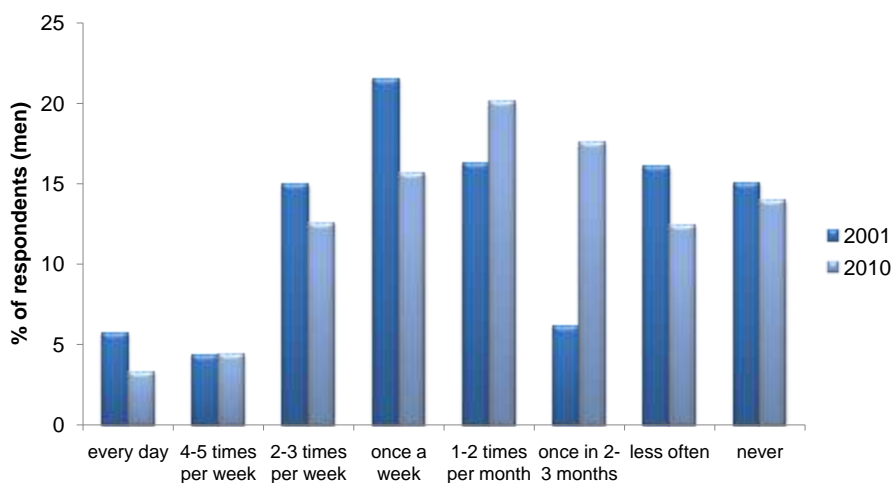

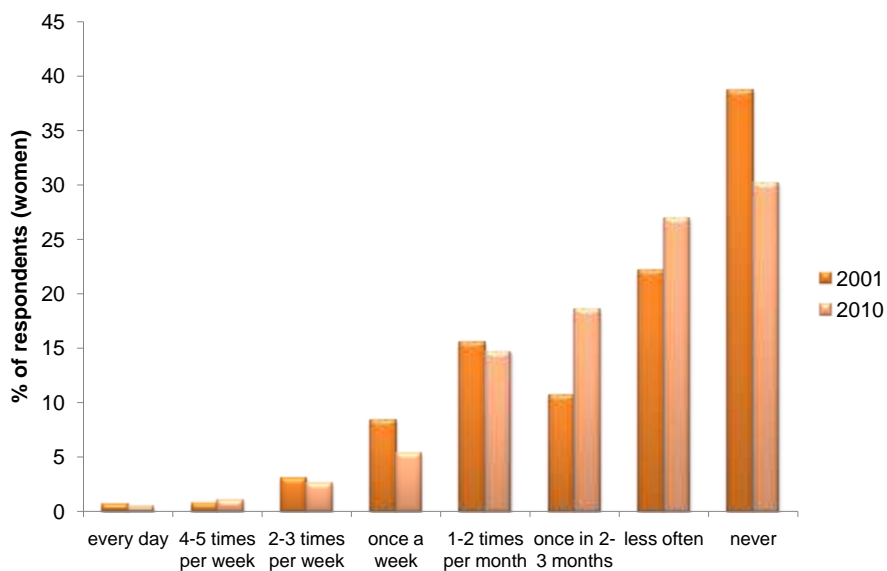

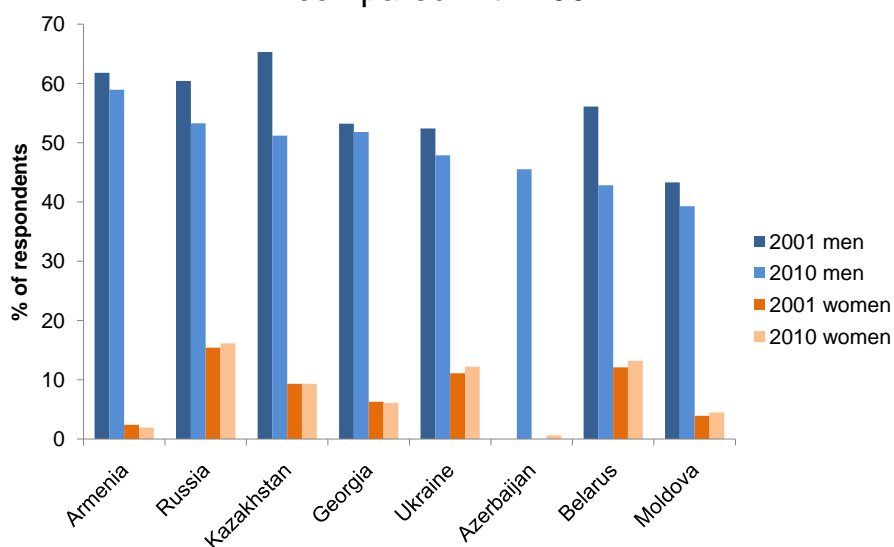
Men's alcohol use in 2010 compared with 2001



## Women's alcohol use in 2010 compared with 2001

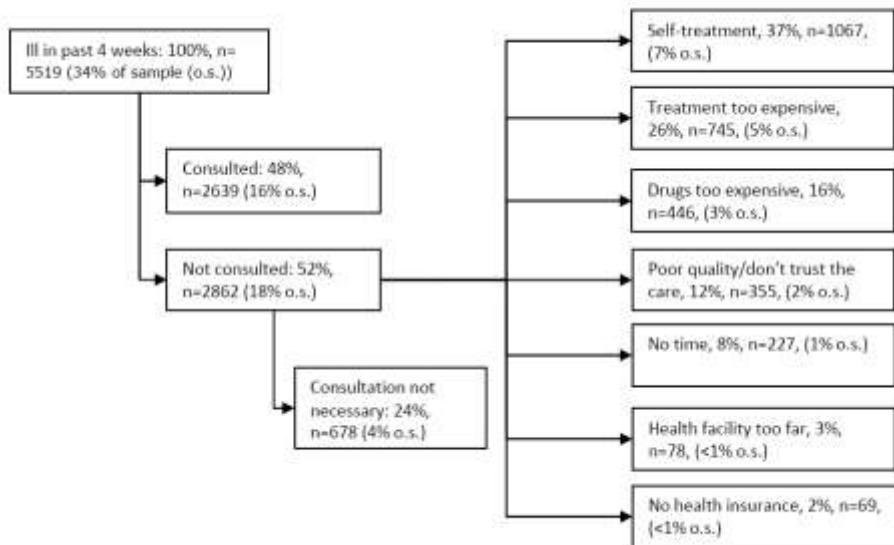


## Prevalence of current tobacco users in 2010 compared with 2001

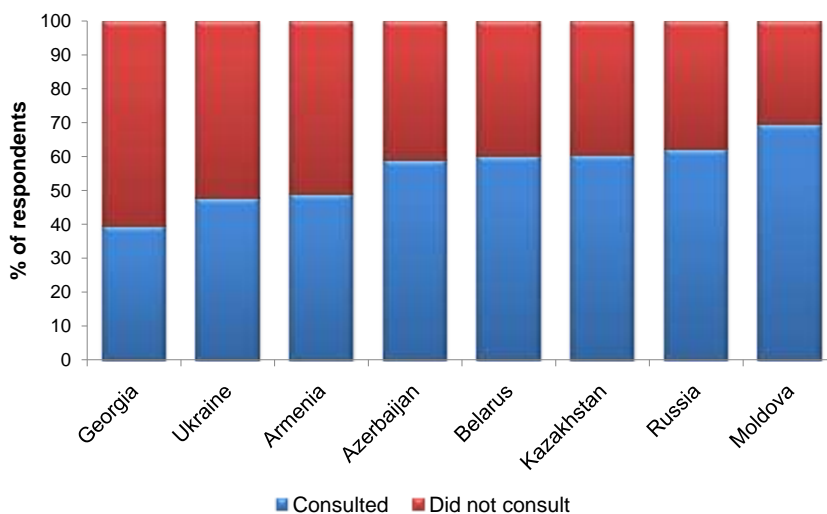

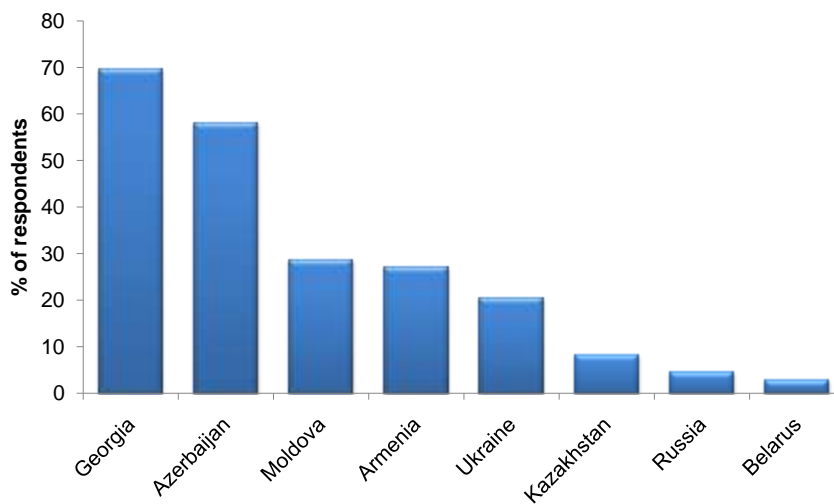
HITT 2010: Illness and consultation pathway in the last 4 weeks, all countries



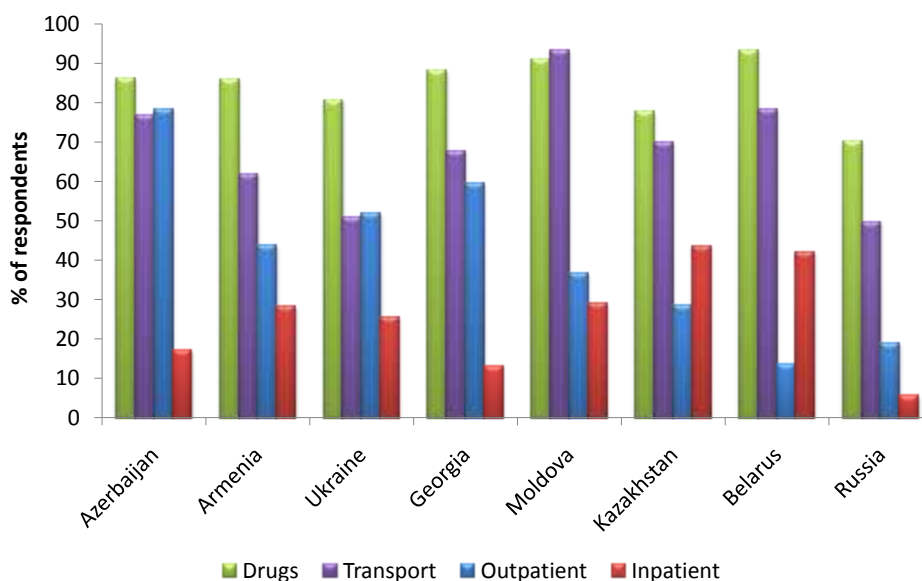

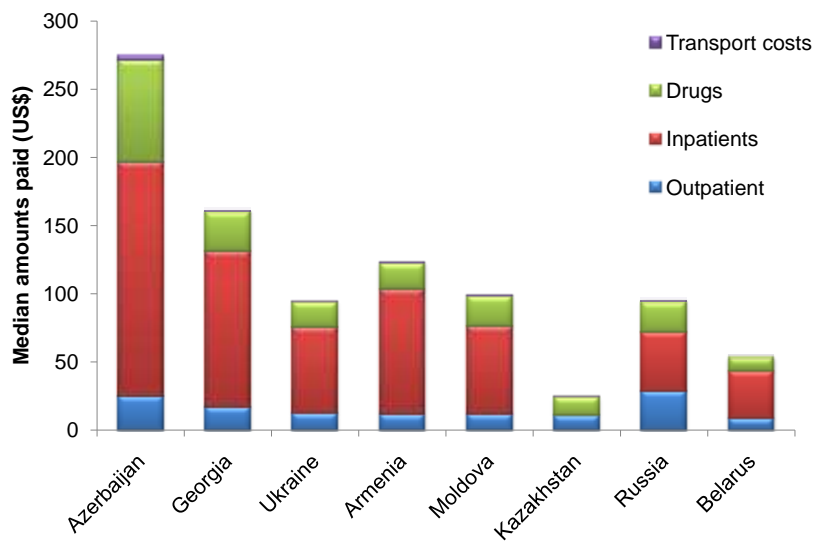
HITT 2010 data: economic reasons for not consulting a health professional for those who had a health problem in the last 4 weeks (N=2862, multiple responses allowed)



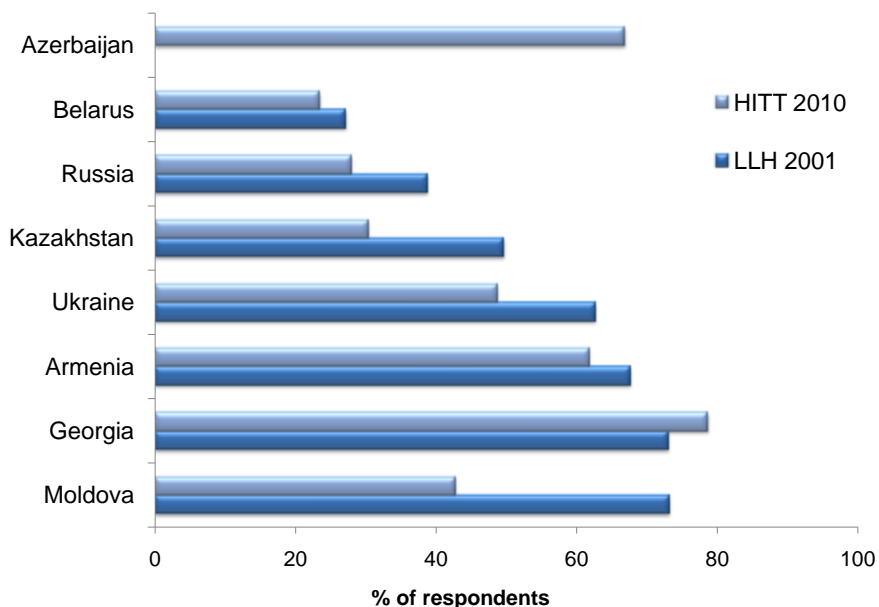
The proportion of respondents having to make a payment for obtaining health care (transport, outpatient, inpatient and drugs) (HITT 2010)
